Images of deities are none other than the nature of our mind, the archetypes of the psyche. Celestial bodies are named after gods and goddesses from many mythic traditions.

When certain planets, asteroids, or stars are prominent in the sky at the moment of our birth, they inspire the mythic narratives of that deity as a guiding influence in our life. The power places of the natal chart are the *Ascendant degree* and its *ruling planet* which point to the topics that motivate and steer your life to its destiny, the *Sun* which is connected to the content of your life purpose, the *Moon* which shows how you apply that purpose in daily life, and the *Midheaven* degree which speaks to your realized accomplishments in society.

The following list contains a selection of mythic named asteroids from pantheons of the Greco-Roman, Egyptian, Celtic, Norse, Hindu, Ancient Near Eastern, American, and other world traditions. Some of them will be the ones that are most prominent in your own natal chart based upon the date and time of your birth. You can honor your personal deities through ritual, meditation, archetypal therapy, home and garden altars, professional and service activities, art, collage, music, writing, research, and travel to sacred sites.
