



Traveling to Bend, Oregon

Getting Here

By Plane

It is highly recommended to fly into Redmond airport (airport code: RDM) and take an uber or lyft from the airport into Bend (about 20-25 minute drive). Getting transportation from Portland is possible but a hassle. Rental cars are available at the Portland and Redmond airports should you want to drive yourself.

By Bus

*Bus trips to and from Portland and Bend are usually 3-4 hours depending on your destination. Keep in mind ski season and winter weather may delay the route.

The *Breeze* bus services between Portland and Bend with stops in between. Round trip tickets from Portland to Bend will run around \$100.

The *Northwest Navigator* is a luxury transportation provider and would be a great option for a group of people wanting to share a ride together. Once you know your travel details, you can contact them to arrange a courier.

Shuttle Oregon is a popular shuttle service with great reviews, servicing Portland to Bend.
